



2017 Hawaiian Hula Days Vendor Information

Please review carefully before registering as the vendor hours and directives have changed in order to enhance the attendee experience and assist the Hula Association in running a successful event.

- Tables are chosen on a first come first served basis and can be set up and open no earlier than 7:30 am on Saturday & Sunday.
- On Saturday, vendors are able to sell in the designated marketplace area just outside the ballroom from **7:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.** **Vendor tables are not permitted inside the ballroom during ho'ike.** Vendor to decide preferred hours and duration goods will be sold between the given time frame.
- Vendor may move table/goods into the ballroom after 10:00 p.m. to be left there overnight and locked in until the next morning.
- Sales for Sunday conclude at 5:00 p.m.
- **No food items for sale** with the exception of the authorized food vendor (by Westin Food & Beverage restrictions).
- Bring a sheet or covering for your table when/if you need to leave it unattended
- You are on your own for lunch (you have the option of eating at the buffet with the participants at a cost of \$40 each day) *** As per previous years, the vendors chip in money towards pizza or have someone run out for food somewhere. Vendors are welcome to eat in the hospitality suite once workshop resumes after lunch – this way you won't miss out on any sales, but yet can have the privacy of the suite to enjoy your lunch.
- Transportation to and from the Westin, delivery of goods, set up & clean up is the responsibility of the vendor.
- Ono Kine Grindz as years past, is the only vendor allowed in the ballroom during Saturday evening's ho'ike as all proceeds they collect are donated in full to the Hula Association.
